<u>Disease/Health Issue Explanation</u>: Stiffness, discomfort and pain are markers of inflammation and degeneration. These kinds of symptoms can be caused through the general wear and tear of life, specific injury or atrophy.

<u>Product Explanation</u>: bring back the ZOOMIES movement drops are designed to address the stiffness, discomfort and pain associated with the general wear and tear of life, specific injury or atrophy. It aids deep muscle, bone, tendon, ligament and surface muscle to enable your pet to enjoy greater mobility and comfort by aiding pain and inflammation.

Purchase Options:

bring back the ZOOMIES movement drops are currently available for purchase in 2 options:

- 1. Pump action bottle
- 2. Refill bottle

The 50ml pump action bottle is suitable for immediate use. The 50ml refill bottle is a replacement for the body of the pump action bottle.

Dosing Instructions:

- Day 1: dose 4 times, half hourly on a small piece of healthy treat. 1 pump = 1 dose. Wait for 15 minutes either side of dosing to feed any meal for greatest efficacy of remedy.
- Days 2, 3 and 4: dose twice daily.
- **Day 5 onward**: dose daily in water bowl, if needed.

Short-term, specific and recoverable injuries, and chronic conditions, all require different dosing and maintenance protocols. See 'Maintenance' below.

Expectations:

Expectations are based on known veterinary principles and the experiences of 12 triallists of bring back the ZOOMIES movement drops.

- Pets who took part in the trial all had the same experiences within the first week the newest symptoms ceased. As with any health condition the newest symptoms disappear first, upon healing protocols being applied.
- The results were satisfying, quickly. Within 3 days, all participants saw results.
- This has proven highly efficacious, in long-term circumstances across 3 different trialled dogs;
 - 1. A Boxer dog that had undergone major leg surgery under the age of 1 (see pictures). The pup had multiple surgeries and his leg did not heal particularly well. Over a period of about 18 months, his leg healed deformed with severe arthritis and his long-term prognosis was a very limited lifespan, motor skills shutting down from back end (where his injury had been) and moving forward. 'Jake' was the initial tester of the ZOOMIES blend. He lived to nearly 14 years of age, extremely comfortably. He was able to enjoy life to the fullest taking long daily walks, and enjoying running around in the back yard with his ball.
 - 2. CinCin, a young Staffordshire Bull Terrier, was diagnosed as potentially needing a cruciate ligament repair. His owner could not afford the procedure, and so we tried the ZOOMIES blend on him. CinCin healed up nicely and did not require surgery. <u>ROAR does not recommend going against veterinary advice. His owner was not in a position to go ahead with the surgery</u>. Fortunately, he did extremely well on this blend and has enjoyed life to the full ever since.
 - 3. Archie, a young Mastiff/Staffordshire Bull Terrier/Sharpei cross, came to his owner with a leg that had a cut down to the bone (see pictures). He could not put weight on his leg, and if he did, he would limp for about 24 hours. Using ZOOMIES, and massage techniques, you would never know Archie had ever been lame. He maintains great physical fitness now.

Maintenance:

Maintenance is dependent on the condition being treated. 3 rules to follow for this are:

- 1. For a short term injury (a knock, bang or twist, in an otherwise healthy pet), following dosing instructions above. Dose as necessary, post healed injury. Dose if symptoms reappear, and cease upon them leaving.
- For a specific recoverable injury (cruciate repair, torn tendons/ligaments/muscles), follow dosing instructions above. From day 5, follow daily dosing in water bowl, or continue dosing on a treat, until symptoms nearly disappear. Dose once a week on a treat, from then on.
- 3. For an ongoing condition (mild to moderate arthritis, shortened ligaments), follow dosing instructions above. Symptoms will greatly alleviate. So your pet can continue to enjoy much greater mobility, keep drops in water bowl consistently.

Dispensing:

bring back the ZOOMIES drops are dispensed in 50ml aluminium bottles with pump action dispensing. This is a deliberate move away from traditionally prepared remedies where drops are dispensed by a self-limiting dropper. The pump action prevents bacterial contamination (that easily occurs when administering drops into an animal's mouth through a dropper), as well as providing a measured dose. 1 pump = 1 dose. Each 50ml bottle contains 130 doses.

bring back the ZOOMIES movement drops are:

- entirely non-toxic and safe for use for any animal but not recommended for animals 12 weeks or under as it may loosen stools,
- safely used alongside current prescription medication and supplementation,
- safe for use in pregnant and lactating animals,
- made in New Zealand, from products sourced in New Zealand,
- guaranteed for a shelf-life of 2 years.

Storage:

The remedy must be stored in a cool place, away from direct sunlight, heat and strong smells, as this is proven to break down the efficacy of the product. An ideal storage space is a bedroom drawer or a kitchen cupboard away from strong smelling substances (e.g. spices) and heat (e.g. where the sun hits or where the kettle is boiled). As with conventional medicine, the optimal temperature is 10-20 degrees Celsius, for storage. **Do not store in the refrigerator.**

<u>Ingredients</u>: bring back the ZOOMIES movement drops are prepared in a base of vegetable glycerine and spring water. Other ingredients include: Arnica, Bellis perennis, Rhus toxicondron, Causticum, Belladonna, Symphytum., Calendula., Calcium carbonate.

Other Useful Protocols for Maintaining Physical Health: As with all health conditions, finding the cause (trigger) is the crucial element to laying out a path of beneficial treatment. Some common triggers that may cause physical strain/damage are:

- a. A pet or animal can hurt themselves accidentally, in the course of everyday living, e.g. by jumping out of a car and landing in an unnatural or dangerous way;
- b. There may be an underlying weakness that triggers degeneration;
- c. Inappropriate exercise (e.g. considering age, weight or size) may be undertaken that causes physical damage, etc.

These things may cause acute (an injury that heals within 3 weeks) or chronic (an injury that is older than 3 weeks) strains or damages. Although bring back the ZOOMIES is beneficial for both acute and chronic cases, it is important to assess the cause and eliminate it as much as possible. This may mean modification of your pet or animal's lifestyle. Examples of this may include:

- a. Moderating the kind of exercise done;
- b. Carrying your pet, or providing a ramp, so a safer exit from the vehicle might be made;
- c. A review of the overall diet to be made to provide a healthier lifestyle, e.g. changing to a healthier diet, weight loss, the addition of some beneficial supplements, etc.

ROAR recommends addressing every possible avenue to aid joint mobility as overall health is such a factor in quality of life.

FAQs

- What if I give more than 1 pump in a dose? Will it hurt them?
 No not at all.
- I don't think I gave my pet a full pump as a dose. Will it still be effective? As long as the dose made contact with the inside of the animal's mouth it

will be effective.

• Can I use the drops on my rabbit? On my horse?

Yes – absolutely. bring back the ZOOMIES drops are suitable for any pet or animal.

• How long will it take to see results?

As with all health concerns, the newest symptoms leave first, upon treatment. Newer injuries or concerns, will symptomatically leave first. Although having said this (there are always exceptions to the general rule), bring back the ZOOMIES tends to see amazingly swift results.

During trialling, dogs experienced greater mobility, comfort – and regained a more cheerful disposition, relatively quickly.
