

Product Name: SPRINGTIME SOOTHER allergy relief drops

Disease/Health Issue Explanation: Pets can suffer much discomfort when coming into contact with common spring time allergens, such as pollens, and grasses. Common immune reactions to such allergens include itching, swelling, rashes and hay fever type responses particularly where your pet makes contact with the allergen – belly, armpits, paws, ears and mouth.

Product Explanation: ROAR's SPRINGTIME SOOTHER allergy relief drops are a unique homeopathic blend specifically formulated to support the immune system of a pet suffering from common spring time allergens. These allergens can be ingested via the respiratory tract or through contact. SPRINGTIME SOOTHER relieves raw, pink itchy skin, pimples and blisters as well as the sneezing and runny eyes associated with common allergies. It is important to address these conditions as they arise as this kind of trauma to skin or respiratory system can create secondary infections.

## Purchase Options

SPRINGTIME SOOTHER allergy relief drops are currently available for purchase in 2 options:

1. Pump action bottle
2. Refill bottle

The 50ml pump action bottle is suitable for cats and dogs starting out their use of SPRINGTIME SOOTHER allergy relief drops and the 50ml refill bottle is a replacement for the body of the pump action bottle.

## Dosing Instructions

- Dose twice daily for 5 days, in a clean mouth. The remedy is at its most efficacious in a clean mouth. 1 pump = 1 dose. To administer, offer dose on a small piece of healthy treat. Wait 15 minutes either side of administering dose to feed. During 15 minutes wait time, clean water only should be offered.

## Expectations

Expectations are based on known veterinary principles and the experiences of more than 100 triallists of **SPRINGTIME SOOTHER** skin relief drops.

SPRINGTIME SOOTHER behaved differently than most homeopathic remedies do – in that it did not follow the general principle that the newest symptoms leave first. Even pets with long term itching found relief quite quickly. Pets that have itching skin also tend to have equally itchy ears. Often the ears will give off an odour as the itch subsides.

Biting, licking and scratching of commonly itchy areas subsides quite quickly – even in long-term cases.

Even in cases where the pet has been on steroids for inflammation the gentle remedy seems to be able to override the harsh chemicals to bring relief to an unrelieved allergy condition.

Often times, the spring time allergy is provoked into a year round problem if not resolved within a 3 week time frame. Generally, triallists have been given steroids which result in shorter and shorter effective bouts of treatment. But the good news has been the rapid effectiveness of the remedy even in complex cases like these.

## Maintenance

Maintenance is based on what is required to keep the symptoms at bay. If your pet came into contact with Wandering Jew, for example, and the symptoms subsided during the initial treatment, there is no need for any kind of maintenance protocol.

If your pet is frequently exposed to such allergens, maintenance will be required. Generally speaking, if there is a flare up – dose every 15 minutes for 3 doses, stopping when symptoms subside.

## Dispensing

SPRINGTIME SOOTHER allergy relief drops are dispensed in 50ml aluminium bottles with pump action dispensing. This is a deliberate move away from traditionally prepared remedies where drops are dispensed by a self-limiting dropper. The pump action prevents bacterial contamination (that easily occurs when administering drops into an animal's mouth through a dropper), as well as providing a measured dose. 1 pump = 1 dose. Each 50ml bottle contains 130 doses.

SPRINGTIME SOOTHER allergy relief drops are:

- entirely non-toxic and safe for use for any animal but not recommended for animals 12 weeks or under as it may loosen stools,
- safely used alongside current prescription medication and supplementation,
- safe for use in pregnant and lactating animals,
- made in New Zealand, from products sourced in New Zealand,
- guaranteed for a shelf-life of 2 years.

### Storage

The remedy must be stored in a cool place, away from direct sunlight, heat and strong smells, as this is proven to break down the efficacy of the product. An ideal storage space is a bedroom drawer or a kitchen cupboard away from strong smelling substances (e.g. spices) and heat (e.g. where the sun hits or where the kettle is boiled). As with conventional medicine, the optimal temperature is 10-20 degrees Celsius, for storage. Do not store in the refrigerator.

### Ingredients

SPRINGTIME SOOTHER allergy relief drops are prepared in a base of vegetable glycerine and

spring water. Other ingredients include: a mix of common allergens, histamine and cortisone.

### Other Useful Protocols for Maintaining Skin and Respiratory Health During Seasonal Allergen Responses

Removal of the trigger is always the best place to start – but of course this is not always possible. If full removal of the trigger, e.g. removing Kikuyu or Wandering Jew from your garden, is not possible, try creating a barrier between your pet and the antagonist. This might mean putting socks on your dog as you walk him along paths that have such allergens, or putting a barrier cream on affected areas. A good thing to remember too, is that dogs are creatures of habit. If they have become accustomed to chewing their feet, they will continue to do it – sometimes long after any antagonist has gone. A barrier for this kind of behaviour is important too. For example, you may keep socks on your dog's feet indoors if they are accustomed to chewing their feet, or even consider using a pool noodle around their neck, fastened with a hair tie, to block them from chewing at healing skin. I have seen healing wonders

happen from using the drops, accompanied by a physical aid blocking them from excessively bothering their skin.

Where there is open, raw skin you may want to consider the use of the HOT SPOT probiotic spray. This can be sprayed directly onto any open wounds.

## FAQs

- What if I give more than 1 pump in a dose? Will it hurt them?

*No - not at all.*

- I don't think I gave my pet a full pump as a dose. Will it still be effective?

*As long as the dose made contact with the inside of the animal's mouth it will be effective.*

- Can I use the drops on my rabbit? On my horse?

*Yes - absolutely. SPRING TIME SOOTHER allergy relief drops are suitable for any pet or animal.*

- How long will it take to see results?

*Results should be noticeable within 48 hours - but itching should have resolved within 5 days. If this is not the case, there may be another potential trigger (e.g. food) that is not a spring time allergen.*
