

Product Name: OLDTIMER senior support drops

Disease/Health Issue Explanation: Ageing is not a health issue or a disease, but a gentle disintegration of the more robustness of youth. Common signs of ageing include physical stiffness, gastrointestinal complaints and/or degeneration, less vigour in standing up to the general wear and tear of life and loss of skin and fur health. Ageing can't be reversed, but it can be managed in such a way that your pet can still enjoy their golden years in a better state of wellness and vigour.

Product Explanation: OLDTIMER senior support drops act as a multi-faceted tonic for pets aged 7 and over. The age of 7 is a bit of a magic number, in the life of a pet. At this age it is not uncommon for owners to see a change in their pet's health and find that they react (or react differently) to things which once they didn't. In some cases, it's like they are an entirely different animal and things require a bit of change and sometimes, an entire reboot. OLDTIMER acts as a digestive aid – as well as a nutritional tonic – helping gastrointestinal ailments (including having gentle liver and kidney cleansing qualities). It also aids in organ wellness, supports the immune system in cases of chronic illness, eases aches and pains (including the shortening of ligaments and tendons – a common complaint in ageing pets), arthritis and general wound healing. It is a tonic designed for common aspects of ageing and their gentle relief.

Purchase Options: OLDTIMER senior support drops are currently available for purchase in 2 options:

1. Pump action bottle
2. Refill bottle

The 50ml pump action bottle is suitable for the initial purchase and the 50ml refill bottle is a replacement for the body of the pump action bottle.

Dosing Instructions: 1 pump = 1 dose. If your pet drinks from their water bowl regularly, pump 2 doses into a clean water bowl daily. Alternatively, pump 1 dose onto a small piece of healthy treat twice daily. Wait 15 minutes either side

of dosing to feed a meal. OLDTIMER senior support drops are at their most efficacious when given like this.

This blend is safe for long term dosing.

Expectations:

This well-trialled remedy has seen many senior animals find renewed vigour – running when once they struggled to stand from sitting, and even run up stairs. They enjoy their food more – as this blend increases gut health, and provides a gentle liver and kidney cleanser, keeping their GI tract in greater health. One triallist described her dog's experiences as 'a lot of gentle changes overall – that lead to a big change'. One of the great beauties of this remedy is that it does nothing drastic. It produces nothing negative. All changes are within a framework of overall health.

Dispensing: OLDTIMER senior support drops are dispensed in 50ml aluminium bottles with pump action dispensing. This is a deliberate move away from traditionally prepared remedies where drops are dispensed by a self-limiting dropper. The pump action prevents bacterial contamination (that easily occurs when administering drops into an animal's mouth through a dropper), as well as providing a measured dose. 1 pump = 1 dose. Each 50ml bottle contains 130 doses.

OLDTIMER senior support drops are:

- entirely non-toxic and safe for use for any animal but not recommended for animals 12 weeks or under as it may loosen stools,
- safely used alongside current prescription medication and supplementation,
- safe for use in pregnant and lactating animals,
- made in New Zealand, from products sourced in New Zealand,
- guaranteed for a shelf-life of 2 years.

Storage: **The remedy must be stored in a cool place, away from direct sunlight, heat and strong smells, as this is proven to break down the efficacy**

of the product. An ideal storage space is a bedroom drawer or a kitchen cupboard away from strong smelling substances (e.g. spices) and heat (e.g. where the sun hits or where the kettle is boiled). As with conventional medicine, the optimal temperature is 10-20 degrees Celsius, for storage. **Do not store in the refrigerator.**

Ingredients: OLDTIMER senior support drops are prepared in a base of vegetable glycerine and spring water. Other ingredients include: Alfalfa, Causticum, Crataegus, Harpopagophytum, Carduus and Zine.

Other Useful Protocols for Helping Senior Pets: As with people, a good attitude about maintaining health in senior years is to start early. As discussed under 'Product Explanation', the age of 7 is when your pet can seem to develop symptoms, or have reactions to things, that he never reacted to before.

I have met many people over years of working in a vet clinic and case management, who have come in with their pet who has been fine their entire life – until they aren't. And the pet was always aged between 6-8 years. The pet is no longer young... it can no longer rely in youthful vigour to keep pushing forward. They are much more affected by things.

Let's start with their diet. A good general key to health is that 'GOOD HEALTH EQUALS A VARIETY OF HIGH QUALITY, SPECIES APPROPRIATE FOOD OVER TIME'. A healthy pet should have a variety of proteins, over time. Commercial pet foods rely HEAVILY on beef and chicken. 80% of cases of itchy skin found their skin to clear up after relinquishing beef and chicken from their diet. OVERUSE OF ANY PROTEIN WILL CREATE AN ILL-TOLERANCE TO THE YOUR PET – NOT NECESSARILY AN ALLERGY... BUT IT WILL CAUSE HEALTH PROBLEMS.

Instead of waiting for problems to arise – be proactive and get your pet onto great quality, natural, grain-free foods – preferably non-farmed.

Adding probiotics and broth, conservatively to begin with, is a great idea, in the cause of helping create a healthier gut for your pet, also.

Secondly... conventional worm and flea treatments are EXTREMELY harsh on pets. Particularly oral treatments. A quick Google of the manufacturer will disclose the side effects of their treatments... 'death, seizures...' ... you can read

it for yourself. And there are other ways to treat these conditions without orally poisoning your pet. ROAR offers a gentle flea program, as well as a natural worming option. There are other ways to alleviate your pets of parasites too – diatomaceous earth, a gentle clay slurry, natural rabbit tails acting as a natural broom in your pet's digestive tract... these can all work in combination.

Thirdly... make activity appropriate for your pet. Inappropriate activity can cause all manner of issues, over time. Make allowances for your pet's breed, age, weight and overall ability. Consider how he gets in and out of the car, how he runs and leaps... these activities can cause huge joint strain.

Make allowances for the fact that pets tend to become more anxious as they age. Provide a safe space that is all theirs. Be aware of new pets in your neighbourhood, or ones behaving aggressively with your pet. Remember – pets have feelings too, and they experience anxiety, depression and fear just like us. Help them feel safe in their own home.

FAQs

- What if I give more than 1 pump in a dose? Will it hurt them?

No – not at all.

- I don't think I gave my pet a full pump as a dose. Will it still be effective?

As long as the dose made contact with the inside of the animal's mouth it will be effective.

- Can I use the drops on my rabbit? On my horse?
